1. Introduction

This document contains the results related to “*Task 1.6.1: Prepare and conduct formal training/workshops in targeted areas*” included in the Activity 1.6 - *Prepare and conduct formal training/workshops in targeted areas* from Component 1 of the Road Safety Technical Assistance (TA) under the Results-Based Road Maintenance and Safety Project (RRMSP). At present this Task is concluded, after the road safety gap analysis and the Steering Committee decision (held on October 28th, 2019) about the venue, date and participation at the planned workshops.

Among others, Component 1 has the objective to prepare and conduct trainings/workshops on

- Road safety management;
- Road safety targeting road component;
- Road safety targeting vehicles;
- Road safety targeting road users.
- Funding and Resource Allocation
- Legislation process

This report describes the training program for the 1-day workshop to be organized for the Albanian stakeholders on the following targeted areas:

- Road safety management;
- Road safety targeting road component.

The training program is based on gap analysis and on a training needs assessment performed with road safety stakeholders.

One of the objectives of the course is to develop internal capabilities of road safety stakeholders’ staff to conduct “Result based” institutional functions.

The course will be delivered by M. Francisco Reina Barranco, a senior road safety expert with more than 15 years ‘experience in road safety.

The course is expected to be held in March 2021.

2. Participation criteria

According to the last Steering Committee meeting, the decision is that the participants will be from the following four categories:

1. Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy (all agencies)
2. Ministry of Interior (Traffic Police Department)
3. Ministry of Health (all agencies)
4. Municipalities and communes
5. Civil Society (i.e. NGO)

- Senior managers in key national road safety agencies and public bodies
- Free participation to any interested entity
